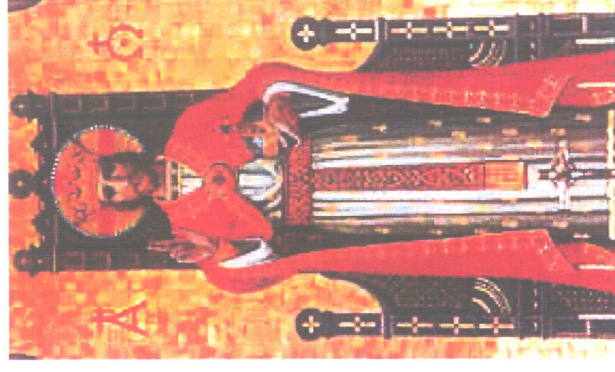
### *Master of Ceremony*

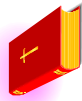

## *Ushers*

- As the first persons that parishioners have contact with before the masses or other activities, ushers greet individuals, answer questions, and make parishioners as comfortable as possible
  - Ushers continuously observe the entire congregation to be aware of people needing assistance and provide assistance as needed
  - Ushers assist the president by performing other activities such as seating people, taking up collections, controlling noise/distractions, handing out bulletins/other materials, and (after mass) assuring that articles left in the pews/floors are picked up and discarded or placed in their proper place
